Listing under 2 categories if appropriate i.e. eat & shop  
Two representatives at HNBA AGM, Workshops, & Meet & Greet networking  
Priority hosting eligibility for Monthly social networking HNBA meeting  
HNBA member window transfer for business or vehicle

**ASSOCIATE membership \$100 + GST** per annum per additional staff member is available if your business has additional staff that wish to attend meet & greets. One additional HNBA membership Lanyard
